

First Aid Policy

The First Aid kit is in a large green box visible under the alcove behind the therapist's work chair.

A First Aid book is available with it.

It contains plasters and sterilised cotton wool.

Chlorhexidine to swab wounds is on the electrolysis trolley.

Cling Film is in a cupboard to apply loosely to burns.

Heat or electrical burns should be held under running water for 10 minutes, after the area has been made safe.

Chemical Burns should be held under cold running water for at least 10 minutes, the container from which the chemical came should be identified and advice sought.

Sharps injuries which break the skin should be squeezed whilst rinsing under cold water, chlorhexidine applied, and medical attention sought in the case of an infection risk from a used needle.

The client's notes contain declared health risks and GP contact details.
